Introduction

The purpose of this document is to define each of the fields which a local contributor will be sharing with the central repository. Each of the fields which is required for incident and arrest submission is defined in detail. Editing criteria, applicable values and cross field edits are also set forth. Using this document, a local contributor should be able to define requirements for an "extract" which would read data from its database and format a file as defined in the Input Specifications.

Throughout this document notation conventions have been utilized to make the manuscript easier to understand. These conventions are described below.

Whenever a value is enclosed in brackets (i.e. [999]), the value which is surrounded specifies a field number. All fields which a local contributor will share with the central repository have been assigned numbers.

Each value that is enclosed in braces (i.e. {0101}) signifies an error code which will be generated if a field is in error. A listing of error numbers and messages is included at the end of this document.

A glossary of terms has been included at the end of the document to clarify certain words and phrases.
